MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 16, S. 2022

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A BLOOD DONOR'S PROGRAM IN EVERY BARANGAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TERESA

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution states that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people;

WHEREAS, this municipality is mandated to exercise powers, as stated in Section 16 of Republic Act 7160, The Local Government Code of 1991, to ensure the health, safety and security of the constituents to preserve and promote the general welfare of the people and the municipality;

WHEREAS, this pertains to ordinance to create and establish a Blood Donor's Program within the barangay level, this is necessary towards the objective of saving lives and in addressing medical assistance for the constituents who may need blood for having been afflicted with an illness;

WHEREAS, this can substantially address the issue where scarcity and insufficiency of blood supply prevails;

WHEREAS, Blood Donor's Program is a positive approach to sustain the adequacy of blood supply in possession of the Philippine Red Cross which can be used for emergency blood requirements;

WHEREAS, the Blood Donor's Program is a Life Saving Initiative to save lives and ensure health and wellness;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained-by the Sangguniang Bayan of Teresa, Rizal in session assembled to enact:

SECTION 1. TITLE – This Ordinance shall be known as *An Ordinance Establishing a Blood Donor's Program in the Municipality of Teresa.*

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF POLICY – In order to promote health, the Municipal Government of Teresa adopts the following policy:

- 2.1 To promote and encourage voluntary blood donation by the citizenry and to instill public consciousness of the principle that blood donation is a humanitarian act;
- 2.2 To provide for adequate, safe, affordable supply of blood in every barangay promoting and encouraging voluntary blood donation; and
- 2.3 To inform the public of the importance of voluntary blood donation to curb hazards caused by commercial sale of blood.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS –As used in this ordinance the following term below shall mean as follow:

- 3.1 Voluntary Blood Donor – one who donates blood in one's own volition or initiative and without monetary compensation;
- 3.2 Washing Blood Donor – an individual who has been screened by history and physical examination found to be fit to donate blood and included in list of qualified voluntary blood donor with their specified type;
- 3.3 Blood Bank/Center – a laboratory of institution which has the capability to recruit and screen blood donors, collect, process, store, transport the issue blood for transfusion and provided information and/or education on blood transmissible diseases;
- 3.4 Blood Bank Unit – an institution or facility duly authorized by the Department of Health to recruit and screen donors and collect blood;

3.5 Blood Transfusion Transmissible Disease – disease which may be transmitted through blood transfusion, including but not limited to AIDS, Hepatitis C, Malaria, and Syphilis.

SECTION 4. There shall be Blood Donor Program established in every barangay in the Municipality of Teresa.

SECTION 5. GUIDELINES

- 5.1 The Municipal Government of Teresa shall be the prime mover for the implementation of the program through the issuance of a directive to the Municipal Health Officer and Punong Barangay;
- 5.2 An organized and sustained campaign by the Municipal Health Office, Philippine National Red Cross and lead agencies, local government units particularly the barangays, non- government organizations, print and broadcast media as well as other concerned sectors shall be established;
- 5.3 The Municipal Health Office shall undertake an outreach schedule of blood typing and blood testing of volunteer blood donors in every barangay;
- 5.4 Those who pass a through laboratory screening from blood transfusion transmissible disease shall be considered qualified walking blood donors and shall be called Walking Blood Bank;
- 5.5 All qualified volunteer blood donors or walking blood shall be listed in a master list and shall be a Walking Blood Bank Card; and
- 5.6 A master list of qualified walking blood donors shall be kept by the barangay captain copy furnished the Municipal Health Office and Mayor's office for control purposes.

SECTION 6. If a patient in a barangay needs blood transfusion, the qualified walking blood bank may provide to the patient immediately the needed blood, if both donor and recipient are of the same blood type.

SECTION 7. The walking blood must undergo a laboratory check-up once in every three months to ensure that this blood is not tainted with blood transfusion transmissible diseases.

SECTION 8. Health support Program for the Walking Blood Bank. The walking blood bank shall be entitled for a free medical check-up at the Rural health Unit of Teresa for any sickness or disease.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this ordinance is declared invalid, the other provision hereof not be affected and thereby shall remain in force and effect.

SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any ordinance, resolution, executive orders or other issuances found inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
