MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 06, S. 2023

AN ORDINANCE UPDATING THE CHILDREN'S CODE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF TERESA, RIZAL

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17 Basic Services and Facilities of Republic Act (R.A) 7160 of the Local Government Code of 1991 states that "...local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities enumerated herein.....such basic services and facilities include; social welfare services which include programs and projects on child and youth welfare";

WHEREAS, in compliance to Section 2 of Republic Act 7160 that "....the best interests of children shall be the paramount consideration in all actions concerning them, whether undertaken by public or private social welfare institutions, courts of law, administrative authorities, and legislative bodies, consistent with the principle of First

Third Offense- Fine of Two Thousand Pesos (PhP2,000.00) and suspension of business permit.

In addition, failure to comply with the requirement on warning sign after being given a written warning result to the cancellation of the Mayor's Permit to operate. The parents of the curfew minors shall be meted with the following penalties:

First Offense- Reprimand;

Second Offense- Fine of Five Hundred Pesos (PhP500.00) or Community Service for three (3) hours;

Third Offense- Fine of One Thousand Pesos (PhP1,000.00) or Community Service for six (6) hours.

Section 164. Repealing clause- All ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof not consistent with any provision of this Code are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section 165. Repealing clause- All ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof not consistent with any provision of this Code are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section 166. Effectivity - This Code shall take effect upon compliances with the posting requirements of the Local Government Code.
