↳ MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 15, S. 2023

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SAFETY OF CHILDREN ABOARD MOTORCYCLES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17 Basic Services and Facilities of Republic Act (R.A) 7160 of the Local Government Code of 1991 states that "...local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities enumerated herein.....such basic services and facilities include; social welfare services which include programs and projects on child and youth welfare";

WHEREAS, in compliance to Section 2 of Republic Act 7160 that "...the best interests of children shall be the paramount consideration in all actions concerning them, whether undertaken by public or private social welfare institutions, courts of law, administrative authorities, and legislative bodies, consistent with the principle of First

essential provisions of this Ordinance in their respective annual communications programs.

SECTION 11. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS. The implementation of this Ordinance shall be headed by the Municipal Mayor and includes the Philippine National Police and other authorized person/s by the Local Chief Executive.

SECTION 12. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional, other provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 13. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any laws, rules and regulations which are inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby amended or repealed.


SECTION 14. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect after 15 days of posting in the three (3) consecutive places in the municipality.
