MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 16, S. 2023

AN ORDINANCE ENABLING THE HEALTH AND NUTRITION FOR THE FIRST 1,000 DAYS OF LIFE THROUGH A REINFORCED AND UNIFIED APPROACH FOR MATERNAL, NEWBORN AND CHILD HEALTH AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 15 of the 1987 Constitution mandates the State to protect and promote the right to health of the people and to instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17 Basic Services and Facilities of Republic Act (R.A) 7160 of the Local Government Code of 1991 states that "...local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities enumerated herein.....such basic services and facilities include; social welfare services which include programs and projects on child and youth welfare";

instrumentalities, etc.) must include in annual programs, plans and appropriation in their respective budgetary allocation.

SECTION 14. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason, the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain valid and enforceable.

SECTION 15. REPEALING CLAUSES. All ordinances, executive orders, administrative orders or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 16. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
