MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 27, S. 2023

AN ORDINANCE SUSTAINING EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM TO DESERVING TERESAÑOS STUDENTS OR ALSO KNOWN AS "FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR INDIGENT AND ACADEMICALLY OUTSTANDING STUDENTS", AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF

WHEREAS, Article 14, Section 1 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution, provides for the protection and promotion of the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all;

WHEREAS, further, Paragraph 3 of Section 2, Article 14, of the aforesaid Philippine Constitution also provides for the establishment and maintenance of a system of scholarship grant, student loan programs, subsides, and other incentives which shall be available to deserving students in public school specially to the under-privileged;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17 Basic Services and Facilities of Republic Act (R.A) 7160 of the Local Government Code of 1991 states that "...local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and

7.5 Receiving Six Thousand Pesos or more in other scholarship grants whether national or international; and

7.6 Not attending any Community Service.

SECTION 8. FUNDING SOURCE. The Educational Assistance Fund shall be included yearly in the Annual Budget of the Local Government Unit under the Program Fund.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Should any provisions, section or part of this ordinance be declared by any competent authorities as invalid, the remaining provisions, sections, or part thereof remain to be in full force effect.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect upon approval and compliance necessary requirements set by laws.
